# FOUNDERS MESSAGE

A year ago, after reading the National Facility Strategy published by Gymnastics New Zealand, I decided to embark on a journey of establishing a subregional gymnastics facility to serve our wonderful flourishing community. Selwyn has seen unprecedented growth over the last six years and this was well documented by Gymnastics New Zealand who recognised the need for a new facility to serve the district.

Fortunately, it was relatively easy to find some like-minded individuals who were excited by the prospect of starting a new club, including renowned coaches with impressive credentials within New Zealand Gymnastics. In fact to some, it was a dream come true!

As many of you will already know, over the next 2 years it is our intention to work on a suitable development of a purpose built facility that will incorporate sunken landing pits and a wider range

of complementary amenities reflective of a high quality subregional facility. We are well on our way to firmly establish ourselves in the Gymnastics community in New Zealand, our current facility is the second largest dedicated artistic gymnastics facility in the South Island and we have a fantastically talented crop of gymnasts already who I'm sure will do themselves and the club proud in their future gymnastic careers.

Affinity Gymnastics Academy is a registered charity and the organisation is run as an incorporated society, therefore it is most definitely aimed at serving our community and you have my commitment to ensure that the club will maintain a family centred approach and most of all will have a friendly and welcoming feel. This shouldn't detract however from having good discipline within the gym, a gymnastics facility can be a dangerous place and it is important that all participants respect the gym and listen to their coaches at all times. All of

our staff are accessible before or after coaching sessions to talk to parents and I know that they welcome the opportunity to get to know you and your gymnast(s) better.

We are very excited to have more equipment and mats on the way, our floor rolls and mats from China that suffered significant delays due to the Asian typhoon a few weeks ago, have finally arrived which means that the sprung floor can now be more fully utilised. However, even more exciting is the news that we will be receiving some new equipment from Qatar towards the end of the year which has been at the 48th FIG Artistic World Championships in Doha this month. The equipment includes the FIG competition sprung floor, competition beam and asymmetric bars as well as lots of additional matting.

What we have achieved over a relatively small time period is overwhelming and a huge thank you goes out to all involved. Over the coming months we will be looking for our members to become more active in the operation of the club, especially to help with sub-committees and fund raising.


